III DESCRIPTION

Art. 3. Course of the competition

The total distance of the course is 140 km including 5 special stages. The total distance of the special stages is 30 km. One of the special stages is an approximately 2 km long super special stage which will be run totally on asphalt surface.

Permission to start will not be granted to competitor who (or whose team member) is found on the route otherwise than according to art 13.6. The forbidden roads are the roads that are marked on yellow, grey, black or are unmarked in Finnish roadmaps in the area of Hämeenlinna and Hattula.

Art. 4. Eligible cars

4.2. In the competition the total amount of tyres allowed is six per car. The purchase, marking and checking of the tyres will be performed according to Finnish Rally Championships regulations. More detailed instructions are included in the Competitors' information kit.

Art. 5. Competitors

IV GENERAL OBLIGATIONS

Art. 13. Traffic and service

13.2 Service areas

Service and repairing of the rally cars are allowed only in the service area at Vanajanlinna (address Vanajanlinnantie 485, Hämeenlinna).

For every competitor the organiser reserves a service area according to the Finnish Rally Championship regulations. Written specified applications for joint service and/or other request must be sent to the organiser at latest on Tuesday May 5, 2011 at 21:00 by email <u>ahvenistonau@gmail.com</u>. Applications received after the mentioned day will not be considered. The organiser reserves the right to reject applications.

Each competitor must have a fire extinguisher and a spill kit for eventual oil leakages ready to use. There must also be a ground sheet under the rally car during service.

In case of violences in the service area the penalties are the following:

1 st violence	200€
2 nd violence	400 €
3 rd violence	exclusion of the competition by the decision of the Clerk of the Course

13.3 Refuelling areas

Refuelling is allowed only in marked areas. The refuelling areas are located along the route on petrol stations assigned by the organiser. The refuelling will be performed according to the instruction of ASN. Further details and instructions for the refuelling will be published with the competitors' information kit.

13.6. Reconnaissance

The competition material will be provided during the administrative checks on Saturday May 14, 2011 beginning at 7:00 at the Rally Office at Vanajanlinna. Both drivers must be present and their identification will be checked.

When collecting the material, every competitor has to return the organiser the filled forms including the reconnaissance and contact info. These forms are published as appendices to the competitors' information kit. The technical data form and other documents concerning the rally car will be checked at the Scrutineering.

The reconnaissance stickers have to be fixed to the reconnaissance car according to the organiser's instructions mentioned in the competitors' information kit. The reconnaissance stickers have to be on display during the whole reconnaissance.

During reconnaissance the maximum speed limit is 80 km/h on all special stages unless the traffic signs or signs placed along the route by the organiser indicate otherwise. The reconnaissance must always be made in accordance with the road traffic art. Driving against the route is forbidden. The organiser will oversee the competitors' speed and driving method during reconnaissance. The Police will have their own surveillance on the route and traffic violences will be punished according to the law.

The competitor must obey any commands to halt by any officials of the rally on pain of refusing permission to start the race.

13.6.1. Time of reconnaissance

The reconnaissance will be performed on Saturday May 14, 2011 from 8:00 to 12:00.

Each vehicle and competitor is allowed to traverse every special stage only twice. The schedule for the reconnaissance of the special stages will be published in the competitors' information kit. In these respects the competitors' information kit is a part of these regulations.

V RUNNING OF THE RALLY

Art. 15. Start

The actual start times will be published on the official notice board according to the rally programme. In the competition the international Time Control procedure will be followed.

The start of the rally will take place on Saturday May 14, 2011 at 13:00 at two (2) minute intervals. There won't be parc fermé at the start.

The special stages will be performed so that the first cars will drive at two (2) minute intervals and after the liaison will return to the same special stage. Then the fist and the second round will be driven by turns at one (1) minute intervals.

15.8. When collecting the competition material during administrative checks each crew will receive a road book and two (2) pieces of maps where the route is marked in detail. If the route marked is not obeyed on liaison the crew will be excluded from the race.

Art. 18. Regrouping

Along the route there is a regrouping area where the possible intervals between crews will be reduced. The regrouping areas are also parc fermé areas.

Art. 20. Parc Fermé

20.1.3. At the finish of the rally there will be parc fermé for the Ralli SM and Suomi Cup classes (classes 1-6).

VI SCRUTINEERING

Art. 21. Scrutineering before the start and during the event

Art. 26. Prizes

The prizes will be awarded according to provisional results. The prize giving will be held at the evening gala at Vanajanlinna. There is a free entry to the ceremony and it is obligatory to all awarded competitors.
