3.3. Should a minimum of 3 (three) starters per class not be attained, the competitors in the class concerned will be entered in the next class up but only in the same group.

#### 4. RECONNAISSANCE

4.1. It is forbidden to be without the permission from the organizers on the roads of Kuusalu, Tamsalu, Kadrina, Rakvere, Rägavere ja Vinni parish when rally regulations have been published.

4.2. Organizers allow to reconnaissance accordingly:  
2 (twice) with **SS4, SS5, SS6, SS7(9)** and **SS8**;  
1 (once) with **SS1**.  
Is free **SS2(3)**

## 6. EVENT

### 6.1. Starting area

All cars must enter Rakvere city square no later than 16:30. Latecomers will be fined. Competing car can be brought into the waiting area by team members.

### 6.2. Start interval

Starting interval for Leg 1 is 2 minutes, Starting interval for Leg 2 is 1 minute

### 6.3. Early arrival

Crews may check in early without incurring a penalty at the following Time Controls: **TC 3A, TC 3C, TC 8A ja TC 8B.**

### 6.4. Regrouping controls

During the rally there will be 3 regroupings. When entering Service Park **A** and **D** starting intervals are corrected, resulting from retirements and/or late arrivals. Overnight regrouping will take place based on the results of Leg 1.

### 6.5. Retirement

Retired crew must immediately inform Rally HQ (phone **+372 53 47 03 31** or **+372 56 32 31 60**) of their retirement reasons, fill out the retirement form (found on the final pages of Road Book), submit the form to marshals or the road-opening car and remove competition number from the car.

### 6.6. Re-start after retirement on Leg 1

Retired competitors on Leg 1 who do not submit retirement form to the course clerk can continue on Leg 2 if they go to scrutineering no later than Saturday 18 June by 8:00. Penalty for not getting a finishing time after each SS is 5 minutes. If competitor retires after the finish of SS3 then also a 5 minute penalty is issued.

### 6.7. Flexi Service

The competing car may be returned to the parc fermé before the 45 minutes have elapsed without penalty. Team members can take the car to *Parc Ferme*.

### 6.8. Car wash

It is compulsory to go through each car wash place shown in a Road Book. One team member may be present.

### 6.9. Podium

Awarding takes place on the podium based on provisional final classification.
